- Noise. No external radios or music allowed on job site.
- Hours. No construction work will begin before 7:30 A.M. or continue after 7:00 P.M. Exterior construction work is not permitted on Sunday.
- No animals will be allowed on the job site, whether in or out of a vehicle, except for service animals.
- Portable toilets must be available until and unless permanent toilets are completed/operable and made available for workers.
- Trash. Except as approved by staff, a covered receptacle for trash accumulation at the job site shall be provided, with weekly trash pickup and removal.
- Staging area. All building materials will be stacked and stored on the job site within the existing or proposed driveway only.
- Trespass prohibited. There shall be no trespassing across the adjoining privately owned lots or on any common areas. Unless otherwise approved by SROA, access to a private property by mechanical means shall be limited to the existing or proposed driveway only.
- Per Sunriver Rules & Regulations Section 4.03: Smoking of cigarettes, cigars, pipes, or other substances on or along any road, drive, lane (except within an enclosed motor vehicle), pathway, trail or any SROA owned property is prohibited unless specifically permitted by signage. Outdoor burning of trash or other material and discarding of any burning material, including, without limitation, cigarettes, smoking substances, or warm ashes in other than a fireproof container is prohibited.
