The following are prohibited or not recommended for the following: fire hazard, susceptible to pests/disease, non-native or unsuitable for Sunriver's climate zone, are not drought tolerant or have high water requirements.

PROHIBITED

- Juniper
- Manzanita
- Arborvitae
- Bitterbrush
- Lodgepole pine
- All Brooms
(Scotch, Lydia, etc.)
- Topiary
- Yews

NOT RECOMMENDED

- Quaking Aspen
- Austrian Pine
- Scotch Pine
