



CURRENT STATUS

- ▶ 4,175 homes in Sunriver
 - ▶ 85% subscribe to Bendbroadband
- ► Bendbroadband 10-year contract up for renewal in June 2022

- ► Service quality








PREPARING FOR THE FUTURE

- Video services migrating to the Internet
 - ▶ Netflix, YouTube TV, Hulu, Sling TV, Amazon Prime Video, etc.
- ► Internet services increasing in popularity / necessity

► Many services require both high-speed download and upload

capability





PROPOSED SOLUTION FOR SUNRIVER

- ▶ Upgrade Sunriver Network to Fiber-To-The-Home (FTTH)
 - ► 1Gbps+ upload and download speeds
 - Improved reliability
 - ► Eliminate congestion
 - ▶ Upgradable



CHOICES FOR OWNERS

- ► Two Options for Achieving FTTH in Sunriver
 - Negotiate a new contract with BendBroadband and require they upgrade their network to FTTH
 - 2. Invest in constructing a Sunriver owner financed FTTH network
